12th December 2022. The study analyzed the socio-economic and environmental benefits of electrifying the 12-metre urban bus fleet in Europe (EU27 countries, plus the UK, Norway and Switzerland).

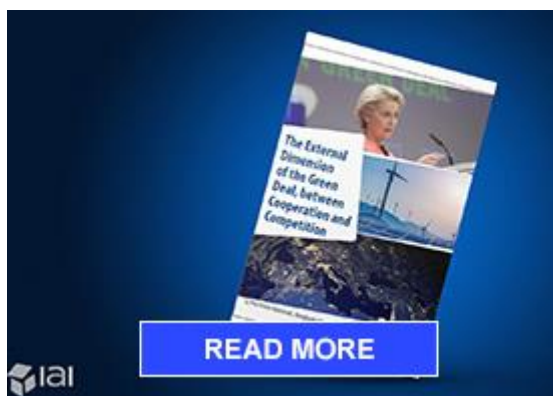


12-16 December,

The speech highlighted how the analysis of global foreign direct investments reveals that sustainability and energy transition are among the most disruptive forces shaping international trade patterns, economy dynamics and geopolitics today.

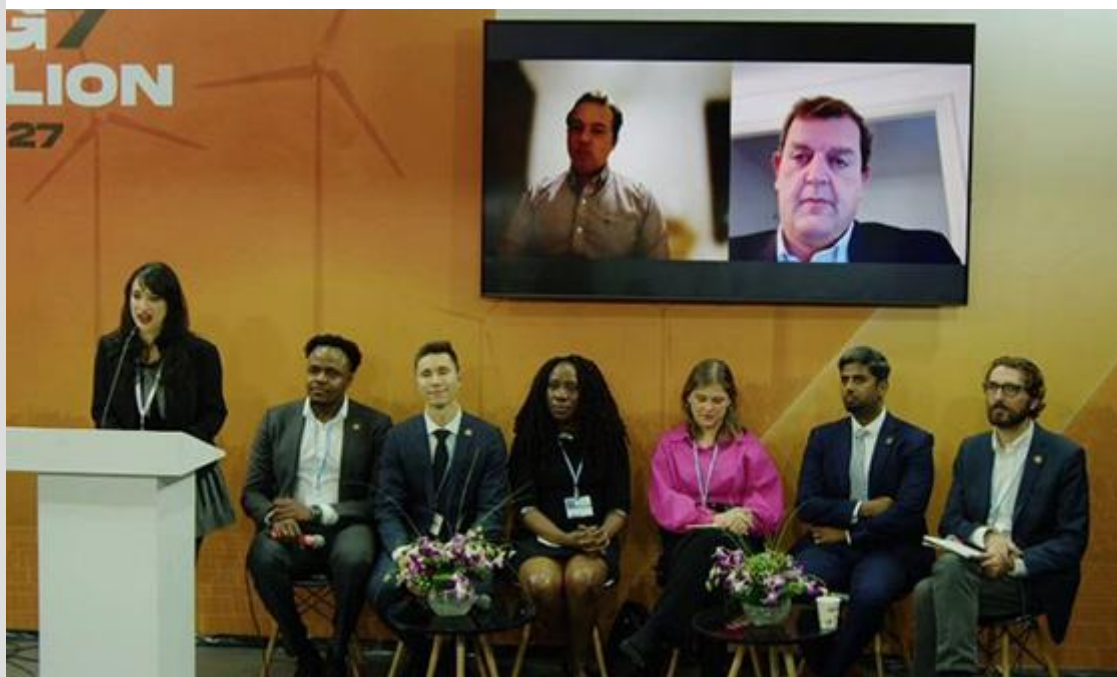


**10 November,
